## BOOKING PROCEDURES/CANCELLATIONS

**ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Check in time: 2:00 PM, Check-out time: 11:00 AM

All guests making reservations and or registering must be 21 years of age or accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Any guest or guests making reservations or arriving at check-in who do not meet the requirements will have their reservation canceled without a refund. All guests in a party will be asked to present a valid form of identification.

**SITES AND RATE OCCUPANCY:** are based on one sleeping unit, one vehicle, and a family of two adults and two children; additional charges may apply.

**RENTAL OCCUPANCY:** Rates include one rental, one vehicle and up to 6 people if space allows. Rental cannot exceed 6 people.

**DEPOSITS:** A deposit of one night's fee for campsites will be charged to the credit card supplied at the time of booking. For rental units, a 25% deposit is due at the time of registration. Booking fees are nonrefundable.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Any campsite reservations canceled 21 days prior to arrival will forfeit the non-refundable deposit. If canceled within 21 days your card on file with the office will be charged for the amount of your stay. For rentals canceled prior to 21 days you will forfeit the 25% non-refundable deposit. If canceled within 21 days the card on file with the office will be charged for the cost of your stay. Day Visitors- must register at the office. There is a charge of \$5 per day

## RULES & REGULATIONS

**OVERNIGHT VISITORS:** must register at the office. Any guests on campground property after 8:00pm are considered overnight guests and a cost of \$10 will apply.

**QUIET HOURS:** Please be respectful of other campers. Quiet hours are enforced between 10pm and 8am. Children need to be at their site at dusk.

**PETS:** Pets must be on a leash, quiet, and cleaned up after. Please no pets in the pool area!

**SPEED LIMIT:** All camp roads have a speed limit of 5mph. Please obey all stop signs.

**ATVs:** ATVs of any kind are not permitted.

**BICYCLES:** Must obey all stop signs. No riding after dark.

**PATIO LIGHTS:** Please do not leave lights on during the night. We do not allow bug lights.

**SMOKING:** We do not allow smoking in the bath house, office, or pool. Please put all butts in the cans labeled throughout the campground.

**CAMPFIRES** must be attended at all times, confined to fire rings, and cannot be over 2 Feet above the rim. Please do not dump ashes and charcoal in the woods.

**FIREWOOD:** It is against the law to bring out of state firewood into Maine. For more information [http://www.maine.gov/dacf/mfs/forest\\_health/invasive\\_threats/firewood.shtm](http://www.maine.gov/dacf/mfs/forest_health/invasive_threats/firewood.shtm). Fire wood is available for purchase at the campground.

**POOL:** There is no lifeguard on duty. Any swimmers under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult. No diving of any sorts. Please do not bring any cans or glass into the pool area. Jeans and disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool. Children who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper.

**POND:** For your safety we do not allow any swimming, wading, or hands in the pond. There are snapping turtles! Fishing is permitted with a State of Maine fishing license.

## WARNINGS
